




OUR BUILDING


Conway Hall opened in 1929 and is named in honour of Moncure Daniel Conway, anti-slavery advocate, outspoken supporter of free thought and biographer of Thomas Paine.


Owned by Conway Hall Ethical Society, a charity, our building is Grade II listed. It offers beautiful spaces with historic features throughout, especially our Main Hall with its distinctive stage and highly-regarded acoustics.

Our Library and Archives hold the Ethical Society's collection, which is the largest and most comprehensive Humanist Research resource of its kind in the UK.









Whether it's the rise of inequality, discrimination, or environmental destruction, there's a growing consensus that our society must prioritise ethics.

With over 200 years of challenging dogma and encouraging independent thought, Conway Hall seeks to bring people together - both in person and online - to think and talk about how we can live together as humans.

There has never been a greater need for equality, social justice and a better life for all. This is what we call Ethics. This is Conway Hall.

Throughout our history, Conway Hall has been at the forefront of addressing pressing societal issues long before they became mainstream concerns.
